

CONFLICT MINERAL POLICY

KIMT LLP (hereinafter the «Company») shares global concerns about human rights violations associated with the illegal mining and trade of Conflict Minerals in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and its neighboring countries.

Policy

As part of the Company's commitment to corporate social responsibility, the Company's goal is to use Conflict Minerals (as mentioned below) that do not directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries (hereinafter the «DRC»).

KIMT LLP Company supports the actions of our Customers to increase the transparency of equipment supply chains, and fully understands the importance of these efforts.

The Company intends to work with suppliers who comply with the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition («EICC») Code of Conduct and conduct their business in alignment with the Company's supply chain responsibility expectations.

Conflict Minerals are defined as gold and tin are used in manufacturing thermoelectric devices as the Company's products.

KIMT LLP makes every effort to ensure that only «non-conflict» materials and components are used in its products.

KIMT LLP may unknowingly receive said materials from the «conflict region», but wants to fully meet the specified requirements. If we become aware that a supplier has obtained these metals from a «conflict» region, Company take appropriate corrective measures in a timely manner, including a reassessment of the relationship with the supplier.

The Company expects its suppliers to take the same measures in relation to its own suppliers to ensure the traceability of materials throughout the supply chain.

The Company intends:

- To interact with manufacturers, request information on the content of Conflict Minerals in raw materials, and promptly respond to customer requests.
 - Cooperate with its suppliers to enable products that are DRC conflict free.
- Encourage its suppliers to purchase materials from smelters who are listed on the Conflict-Free Smelter Program Compliant Smelter List and have been certified as conflict-free by an independent auditor through the Conflict-Free Smelter Program.
 - Make available reports on its progress to concerned parties and the public.
